

## Appendix C: Accidents on Chavenage Lane

when	who	what
Autumn 2010	Hannah Cox	Hannah was in School bus which pulled out from Chavenage Lane into A46 without seeing the oncoming car. Car just managed to stop in time
Winter 2012	Unknown driver	HGV lorry overturned into field just after turning from A46 onto Chavenage Lane.
May/June 2012	Natalie Morrison	Was travelling at 60 mph north on A46. Car in front suddenly slowed to turn into Chavenage Lane without indicating, having appeared to have only just spotted sign. Natalie crashed into the back of the turning car. Her and the children travelling with her suffered whiplash injuries. Can be validated by insurance claim
June 2012	Aileen Wilkinson	Near miss. Travelling north on A46. Approached Chavenage Lane turning. Car on Chavenage Lane pulled out and started to turn right without seeing 4x4 travelling at speed from Nailsworth direction. 4x4 veered in front of both vehicles and crashed into wall opposite.
March 2013	Jordan Huntington	Turning into Chavenage Lane when car went into back of him. Taken to hospital and off work for a week. NB. this would appear to be accident that GHA has record of
Late May/early June 2013	Unknown driver	Signpost to Chavenage was completely smashed by a car veering into it . Carolyn Crowe witnessed this accident. A car was turning right into Chavenage lane and the car behind obviously did not see the car turning until the last minute. There was a sudden application of breaks and the car in question had to swerve to miss the stationary (but turning) car. The highways must be aware of this incident as it resulted in the "South Gloucestershire" sign being knocked down.
14 <sup>th</sup> October 2014	Royal Mail Driver	Ron was travelling towards A46 on Chavenage Lane. Met truck coming towards him on blind corner. Truck could not take evasive action without coming off road. Postman swerved and hit tree. Driver statement can be obtained
11 <sup>th</sup> Nov 2014	Lorry	See photographs in Appendix B of lorry coming off the lane into the field just after turning off the A46 junction
14 <sup>th</sup> Feb and 18 <sup>th</sup> March 2015	vans	2 almost identical accidents on 2 dates a month apart. Vans met cars / lorries coming round blind corner on Chavenage Lane between A46 and proposed site. Vans went into ditch. It is likely there are many more of these that are not witnessed or reported as the drivers are very reluctant to do so
