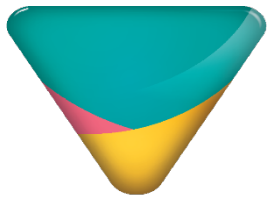

- Vouchers must be **submitted individually** to fund a solution.



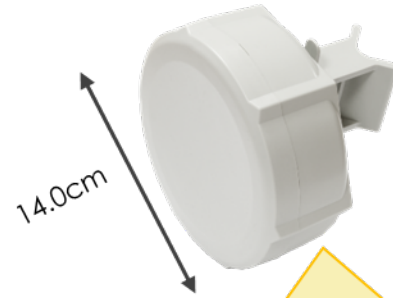
How we plan to do it

The equipment we use

“The sector antenna”



This is a “sector antenna” and is used to send the signal to individual homes. We need several of these to cater for the number of people living in the immediate vicinity of the network



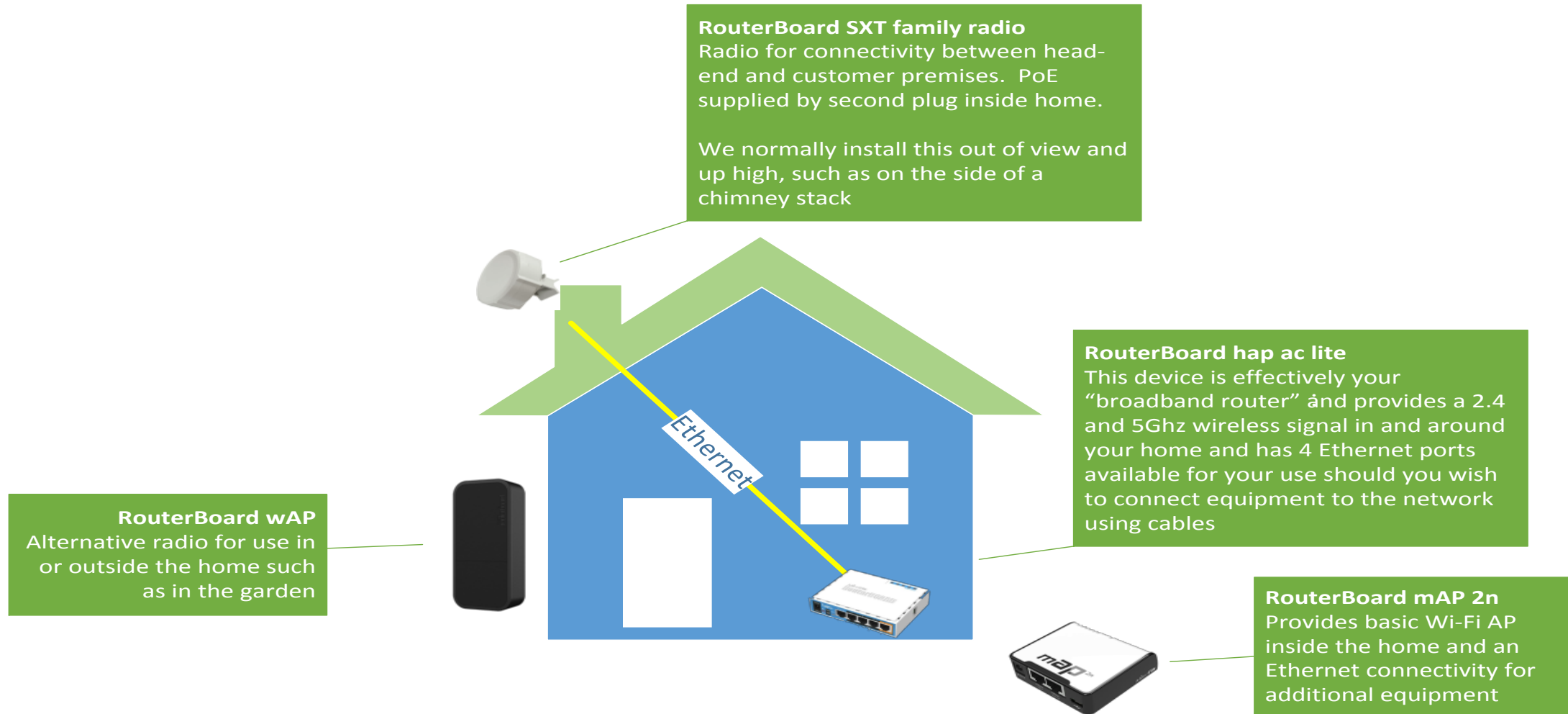
This is a CE radio, we use it to connect individual properties to out network.



This is a “directional antenna” and is used to make a backbone network between master and slave sites.

The Network Plan



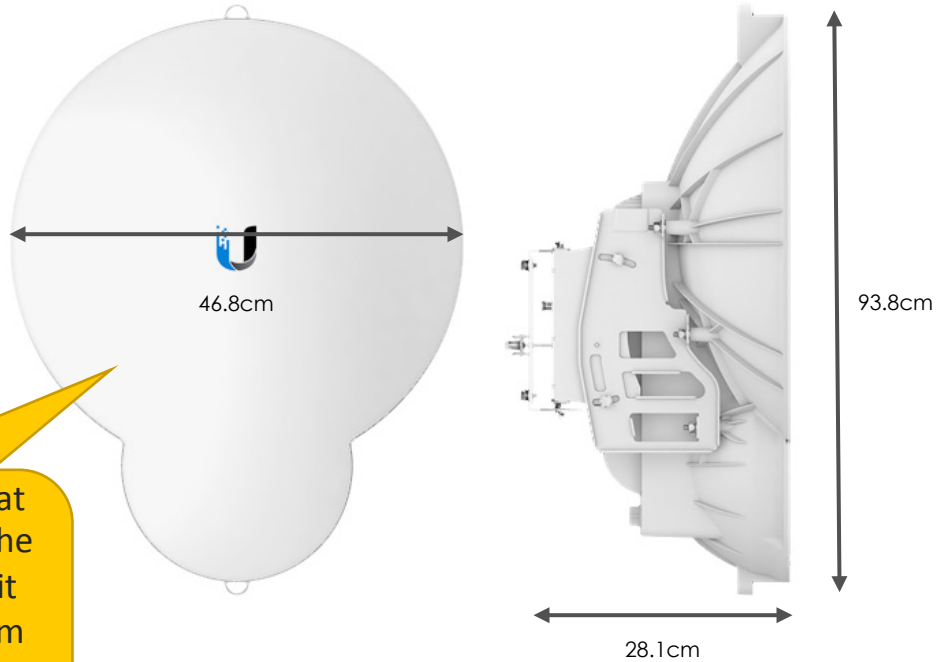

This is the main radio that we install on the top of the A and B sides to transmit all the signals to and from all the subscribers in the network back onto the main internet trunk



One of these radios would be located on this barn.

The Bagpath 'hop' side

We are thinking of installing a small metal structure at the very far edge of the pub that would be secured against tamper, access by kids, etc

According to the modified network plan we would use The Hunters Hall property to situate a hop point serving Bagpath area

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

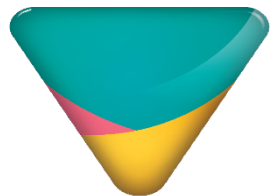
